BUILDING EXTENSION PROJECT STATUS REPORT

Date: 8 August 2025

Subject: Building Permit Submission - Post-Cladding Compliance

Background

Following completion of the cladding works, the Registered Building Surveyor conducted an inspection and issued a detailed list of Requests for Information (RFIs). These RFIs identified several design issues and non-compliances, particularly in relation to fire ratings and other regulatory requirements.

Building Update

Design Revisions and Compliance Measures

A new architect was appointed to revise the design in response to the identified issues. For specific non-compliances, a professional DDA (Disability Discrimination Act) consultant was engaged to prepare a design brief. This brief facilitated the resolution of certain matters through approved alternative solutions, while other items required physical modifications on site to achieve full compliance for both the Building Permit and, ultimately, the Occupancy Permit.

The revised report has been completed and approved by all key stakeholders, including:

- Access Consultants
- Project Architect
- Builder

The architectural drawings have been confirmed as complete. Supporting documentation from the Hydraulic, Fire, Mechanical, and Structural consultants has also been finalised.

Submission for Building Permit

All documentation has been collated and formally submitted to the Registered Building Surveyor on 8 August 2025 for final review and the subsequent issuing of the Building Permit.

Next Steps

- Await feedback or approval from the Building Surveyor.
- Implement any remaining site works required for final compliance.
- · Proceed with completion of works upon issuance of the Building Permit.

Oportant Notice for Sangat – Gas Pipe Theft at Gurdwara Sahib

Dear Members and Sadh Sangat ii

Waheguru Ji Ka Khalsa, Waheguru Ji Ki Fateh

We would like to inform you about a theft that took place at Gurdwara Sahib Blackburn.

The incident occurred on 23rd July. A thief came during the early morning hours, disconnected the copper gas pipe, and removed it from the roof. He threw the pipes over the fence near the liquor shop, where he likely had his car parked.

This caused issues in preparing Langar, as there was no gas for cooking, it also affected the hot water supply used for washing utensils and laundry. Thanks to the sevadars who came together and helped, there was no disruption to the Langar.

The matter was reported to Forest Hill Police Station and is now under police investigation.

After receiving multiple quotes, a plumber was called, and new gas pipes were installed. This time, the pipe has been placed through the roof to make it harder to access and steal.

We are thankful that no one was hurt and no other damage occured apart from the gas pipe.

We would like to thank all the sevadars for their quick response and support during this time. Special thanks to Gurdwara Sahib Hoppers Crossing and Gurdwara Sahib Keysborough for assisting with Langar while our services were affected.

We request all Sangat members to stay alert and report any suspicious activity around the Gurdwara. The committee is reviewing and improving security measures to prevent such incidents in the future.
